DISCOVERING DIEGO SUAREZ

AMBER MOUNTAIN

Very close to the old city of Joffreville, 30 km from Diego Suarez, is the Amber Mountain National Park, culminating at an altitude of 1475 m. In the midst of an abundant flora, many species of lemurs cohabit with noisy birds, taciturn snakes, cheerful butterflies and the champions of camouflage chameleons. Of these latest, the smallest in the world lives here, carpeted under the dead leaves, displaying a perfect mimicry of colors. If you have the eye and a bit of good luck, you will see this chameleon, the Tuberculous Brookesia, the size of a thimble.

LES TROIS BAIES – The Three Bays

The three bays include the ones of Dunes, Pigeons and Sakalava, three generous openings to the Indian Ocean and its impetuous waters. Displaying golden beaches, the three sites aligned side by side are ideal for wind-related nautical activities and today, the one of Sakalava is a worldwide known windsurf and kite-surf destination.

THE TSINGY ROUGE – The Red Tsingy

They are the results of repeated and lasting actions of wind and water. You can't be indifferent in front of these eroded sharp-tipped red-colored mounds. They are called the "Tsingy rouges" and they surprise the visitors with an extraordinary discovery. Why not come and admire?

ANKARANA PARK

Spectacular geological formation! The show is unusual and surprising. This incredible landscape was probably carved under the sea millions of years ago. The Ankarana nature reserve promises you beautiful discoveries, beautiful panoramas, and unique in the world species of fauna and flora which have evolved here, adapting to sometimes very dry climate and to the darkness of the depths of Tsingy fissures.

THE EMERALD SEA

The turquoise, clear and glittering waters give the site an unearthly beauty. This particular color comes from the shallow depth of the sea and the very sandy bottom. The name of Emerald is not usurped.

DISCOVERING FORT DAUPHIN

LOKARO BAY

Lokaro Bay is located 40 km from Fort-Dauphin. Your day excursion begins with a 4WD ride till the shores of Lake Lanirano and continues by waterway for about two hours to the fishermen village of Evatra. From here, you walk to Lokaro Bay. The site is full of charm with its deserted creek, pristine white sand beaches and turquoise waters.

SAIADI BOTANICAL GARDEN

The botanical garden of Saiadi is home to different types of lemurs living in liberty, such as Makis, Sifakas and Brown lemurs (*Fulvus*). To these emblematic primates of Madagascar are added crocodiles, birds and butterflies. The site is adorned with triangular palm trees, endemic to the region. There are also date palms, mango trees, rosewoods and giant bamboos. In the lower strata, we notice the *Typhonodorum*, called "Elephant Ears" because of the shape of its leaves, some ferns and orchids.

NAHAMAPONA

In this magnificent tropical garden, you will make acquaintance with extraordinary fauna and flora, specific to the South-East of Madagascar. Walking here is just a delight thanks to the wealth of vegetal species you meet and to the character of the site, wild and intimate at the same time. As a bonus, colonies of lemurs have settled there.

THE PIC SAINT LOUIS

The Pic Saint Louis is the southern edge of the mountain range that crosses the southeast of the island like a backbone. This massif separates the dry and arid west from the humid and green east. The summit is impressive with its 529 meter height dominating all the valleys and lakes, overlooking on the city and offering a 360° panorama and an incomparable sunset spectacle. A hike to these gneiss blocs on granite base is rather an appealing perspective!

DISCOVERING MAJUNGA

THE CAVES OF ANJOHIBE

It is one of the most important speleological sites in Madagascar. Inside the caves, you will discover numerous limestone concretions forming imposing stalactites and stalagmites that can exceed 10m in height. The cellars communicate with each other like a network-labyrinth of communicating rooms. The surrounding forests still harbor groups of wild lemurs. The site is not lacking in tourist attractions. The track that connects Anjohibe with the national road crosses a savannah with scattered palm trees, shrubs, circular-shaped small ponds called Matsabory, and cashew plantations. A different world for sure!

ANKARAFANTSIKA NATIONAL PARK

Ankarantsika National Park is a vast protected area of 130,000a, composed largely of dense tropical dry partly deciduous forest. There is also a lake ecosystem

and impressive geological formations such as the Ankarokaroka Canyon. Interests in fauna and flora are multiple: 129 species of birds including 66 endemic, 8 species of lemurs, rare insects, reptiles and batrachians. The site is managed by Madagascar National Parks and is located 110km from the town of Majunga.

KATSEPY

Embark on a canoe, a ferry or a speedboat, cross the mouth of the Betsiboka River and you reach the peninsula of Katsepy. This small fishermen village is a pleasant holiday resort with a range of excursions. You can visit the lighthouse and enjoy its magnificent panorama, or visit the Blue Circus, or go on an escapade to the celestite mines of Sankoany or simply choose the relax option on the beach.

DISCOVERING MORONDAVA

KIRINDY FOREST RESERVE

Located 70 km from Morondava, the Kirindy forest reserve has an exceptional floral wealth (medicinal plants, precious wood trees, baobabs, etc.) with a high rate of endemism. The Kirindy forest also allows close observation of Sifaka lemurs, of nocturnal species such as mouse lemurs (Berthae and Murinus species), cat lemurs (Phaner), Vositse (an endemic species of giant rat), of the Fosa (*Cryptoprocta ferox*) the biggest predator and some endemic snakes.

KIVALO

Launched in 2019, the circuit called "Kivalo Soa" reveals the ecological riches of the vast mangrove forest. The site is managed by the local community.

BELO SUR MER

The Belo-sur-Mer peninsula is a charming corner offering visitors an incessant spectacle of fishing canoes coming and going. In the village, the manufacture of dhows is a century-old activity but still relevant and remained totally artisanal. It is the birth place of these big dhows sailing in the Mozambique Channel. Along the coast, rocks and sandy beaches alternate. The immense mangrove forest around the village offers pleasant canoe trips.

Let yourself be seduced by the simplicity and warmth of Anjiabe villagers. Culinary art, crafts, music

and traditional dances are part of the daily life of these inhabitants who will be delighted to share them with you.

NOSY SAKATIA ISLAND

Off the west coast of Nosy be, this island has preserved an original ecosystem, protected and classified because of wonders that are found there. Postcard beaches, rare birds, endemic plants are waiting for you. Hike to the four corners of the island, explore the fishing villages, walk through the fields of vanilla, coffee, or orchids for which the island is famous, and try to tame a lemur in the course of a forest walk.

LOKOBÉ

Lokobe is the remaining protected primary forest of Nosy Be. To the delight of scientists in the region, it shelters many varieties of endemic medicinal plants and ancient trees. The 740 hectares of this reserve include most of the endemic vegetation of Nosy Be.

Endowed with a spectacular coral reef, it is a real living aquarium. Catch sight of sea turtles, rays, dolphins and even small harmless sharks.

DISCOVERING SAINTE MARIE

ILE AUX NATTES

If you dream of a holiday in paradise, go to Nosy Nato, known in French as "Île aux Nattes". Located few meters off the southern coast of Sainte Marie Island, it bears the name of a tree, the Nato, which gives the wood once used for canoe making. Rather small, Île aux Nattes can be walked round in half a day. Vegetation is abundant and impressive. So is the fauna. In addition to beautiful beaches, diving is ideal here.

SAND ISLANDS

Three white-sanded islets on coral base, amidst a magnificent turquoise-colored lagoon! Find them off Sainte-Marie Island's eastern coast. They are named Nosy Rinditra, Nosy Andromba and Nosy Alanana. You will find here all kinds of shells, superb coral reefs surrounded by sand. In the right season, some birds

come to nest. Exotic fish of improbable colors transform the lagoon into lively natural aquarium. A dreamed place for snorkeling!

AMPANIHY BAY

Ampanihy Bay and its huge mangrove forest are rather unknown to tourists. The site has splendid beaches with magnificent white sand, bordering a turquoise blue sea. The place is suitable for swimming, being protected by a coral reef. The magnificent area of countless mangrove trees is fully preserved.

NATURAL SWIMMING POOLS

The site looks like a set of excavations confined by rock barriers, being filled by water brought in by breaking waves. These natural pools are a marvel of nature. The barrier of black rocks adorns the fine sandy beaches.

DISCOVERING SAMBAVA

MAROJEJY NATIONAL PARK

The Marojejy National Park is in the northeastern region of Madagascar between the cities of Andapa and Sambava. To tame the sublime landscape of this imposing massif, you should be a good hiker, ready to climb the steep reliefs. Nature lovers won't be deceived! You will discover a rich nest of biodiversity. Incomparable endemic fauna and flora await you to come. Ferns, palm trees, birds, lemurs, amphibians and reptiles of all kinds live in this humid and wild region. The birds compete in colors, and among them some are endemic such as the Blue Coua or the Siketribes. Add to the spectacle the white-fronted lemurs.

AMBOHIMANITRA DOMAIN

Pay a lovely visit to the "Hill of a thousand perfumes" while on the road to Antalaha. With a size of 30 hectares, it is a firework of vanilla but also cloves, pink peppercorns, ylang-ylang, peppers and cinnamon. You will be able to appreciate the meticulous and rigorous patience of the personnel while caring about vanilla plants, carrying out the required artificial pollination of their flowers. After drying the pods in the open air, workers, mainly women, sort them according to their size. Bunches thus formed are packaged in boxes to be directed abroad; a checker smells each lot in order to remove any "defective" pods.

DISCOVERING TAMATAVE

FORT MANDA

Fort Manda was built by King Radama the 1st between 1826 and 1831. This circumference of 70 meters and 6 meters height used to house the garrison of the royal army and the residence of the governor, a representative of the central monarchy. For the construction, instead of cement, egg white was mixed with coral powder to serve as a binder for the dried stones. Towards the interior, the wall has a lookout path with embrasures for cannons and a walkway, above ground, connected to each other by stairs. 25,000 soldiers of the Royal Malagasy Army were permanently stationed there

THE PANGALANES CHANNEL

Along the east coast of Madagascar south of Tamatave, the Pangalanes canal is a long succession of rivers and lakes. Separated in places from the Indian Ocean by only a few hundred meters of forest or sandbanks, it allows you to enjoy two universes one as charming as the other. On one side lush vegetation, mangroves where fish, lemurs and other reptilians live, and on the other side, endless white sand beach bordering the ocean.

LE PALMARUM

The site is located on the shore of Lake Ampitabe, which forms with the set of surrounding vegetation and villages an idyllic corner known as the "Nest of Dreams", in Malagasy "Akanin'ny Nofy". Palmarium private reserve includes a dozen species of lemurs, rare fauna and diversified flora. You will also find there the most beautiful palm trees of the country.

DISCOVERING TULEAR

MANGILY IFATY

Ifaty and Mangily are two villages in the same area and are reputed to be an extraordinary seaside destination. Entertainments are many. Mangily village is very welcoming and excursions are varied. The lagoon of Ifaty is one of the most beautiful in the world with its 100 km coral reef, ideal for snorkeling and water sports. Diving lovers will make a stopover at the Ranobe lagoon, with beautiful underwater discoveries in expectation.

THE PARK OF TSIMANAMPESOTSE

This park in the south west of Madagascar is known first of all by its 20 km long salt lake. There are 72 species of birds, many lemurs, turtles and reptiles. Among birds, you have the grey-headed lovebirds, crested coots, Madagascar Drongo, parrots, Newton's falcons... Among animals, the spectacular ones are the ring-tailed lemur and the giant-striped mongoose (*Galidictis grandidieri*) found only in this park. The lake has nearly 112 species of birds, the most important being the pink flamingos, dwarf flamingos and Coua birds.

SARODRANO

Sarodrano is known to be an old haunt of pirates and one of the oldest sites occupied by man in Madagascar. This fishing village of Vezo tribe has kept its ancestral charm and its customs. Surrounded by lengthy cliffs shaped by the waters of the Onilahy River, Sarodrano is worth a visit

ANAKAO

This incredibly charming fishing village offers many white sand beaches with turquoise and translucent water. Ideal site for amateurs of diving and sea sports, Anakao is also the starting point for cruises to neighboring islets (Nosy Ve, Nosy Satrana).

PRACTICAL INFORMATION : BEFORE YOU GO

Prepare your trip to Madagascar with serenity. Here you will find all the practical information to determine the best time to go to Madagascar, what the time difference will be from your place of departure, what vaccines are to be expected, or what visa you will be asked to enter the territory.

BEST PERIOD TO GO TO MADAGASCAR

You can come to Madagascar throughout the year. However, some national parks are not accessible during the rainy season from January to March.

Visa for entry and stay in Madagascar

The visa for a single entry and stay in Madagascar is delivered by diplomatic and consular instances or by the landing airport.

The application for a single entry and residence visa for Madagascar can be made either upon arrival at the airport or online via the official eVisa Madagascar website.

A landing authorization will be issued to you via the site within 72 hours. For the moment, the payment of visa fees is done at the airport but you will be redirected to priority counters on your arrival.

WHAT CLIMATE IN MADAGASCAR ?

The climate in Madagascar is very varied according to the regions. The Highlands have a mild climate, the West is warm and dry, the East coast is rainy, the North is hot and humid, and the South semi-arid. The dry season runs from April to October, and the summer, the rainy season, from November to March. The ideal is to leave between September and October or from April to June.

JET LAG

Madagascar is located at GMT + 3. Therefore the island has a time difference of + 1h of South Africa, + 1h in summer and + 2h in winter of Western Europe, + 1h of the Reunion Island and Mauritius, -4h from Thailand, and -5h from Singapore and Honk Kong.

WHAT VACCINES FOR MADAGASCAR?

No vaccination is required to go to Madagascar, unless they have passed through an infected area. Anti-malaria prophylaxis and an injection of gammaglobulin against hepatitis are recommended, as are preventions against cholera and yellow fever. Concerning the epidemics that can occur in the world, the Malagasy health authorities are as reactive and informed as the other states. Finally, if you are passing through or making a stopover of less than 12 hours in Addis Ababa, a note from the Epidemiological Health Surveillance Directorate states that there is no risk for the passenger to contract the Yellow fever, and that it is therefore not necessary to be vaccinated to enter Madagascar.

Presentation of a negative result of an Rt-PCR test performed 72 hours before boarding

Rapid antigen test on arrival

Performing a rapid antigen test upon arrival in Madagascar, at the traveler's expense (15€ / 20\$ / 65.000 MGA)

Positive result to the rapid antigen test on arrival

In case of a positive result to the rapid antigen test on arrival, a 7-day self-isolation at least will be implemented in a dedicated facility, at the traveler's expense.
