






MADAGASCAR TOURIST MAP





The villagers' warm welcome and dishes cooked with local produce are not to be outdone either.

A resort and cultural stay on the main island of Nosy Be, also called the "Perfume Island" and two small neighboring islands: Nosy Komba and Nosy Tanikely. On the agenda - village immersion, a visit rich in culture and history, white sandy beach, discovering endemic wildlife, etc.


